REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP)
Out-of-School Time Expanded Learning Opportunities Grant (OST-ELOs)

On behalf of the Family and Children First Council of Cuyahoga County, Starting Point, the Out-of-School Time Intermediary for Cuyahoga County and MyCom, is now soliciting proposals to provide Out-of-School Time (OST) Expanded Learning Opportunities (ELO), during the 2019 calendar year. These services must be provided to Cuyahoga County youth, enrolled in kindergarten through 12th grade. Only established programs, with an existing service history, are eligible for funding. Eligible programs must offer evidence of consistent youth participation in a program design and improvement process.

A mandatory Pre-Proposal Conference is scheduled for 8:30 a.m. on August 23, 2018 at Jerry Sue Thornton Center, 2500 E. 22nd Street, Cleveland, Ohio 44115
